

LEARNING MATERIALS

You will **find a reading, video or podcast** on the subject you are covering. We will spend one day in class reading the article, or watching the video, or listening to the podcast. It should cover some of the most interesting aspects of your topic and go into significant detail.

TO COMPLETE THIS ASSIGNMENT

First, find a video, podcast or reading that relates to your subject. **Extra credit for making your own*

Second, answer these questions.

1. Why did you choose this material?
2. What do you want people to learn from it?
3. Where did you find it? (source)

Third, download the "Learning Materials" quiz form from the website and create 5 multiple-choice questions. Students should be able to answer them after seeing, hearing or viewing your learning material, but they should not be so easy that they can answer them before they see the material.
